BIKE RIDE / CAR RALLY

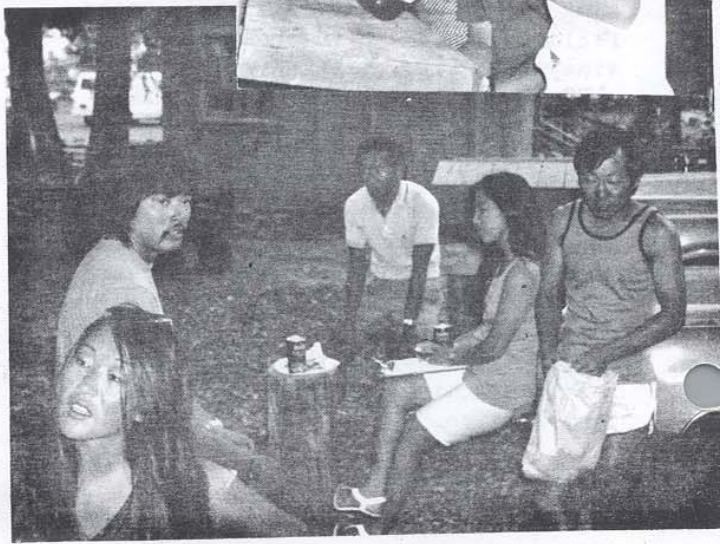
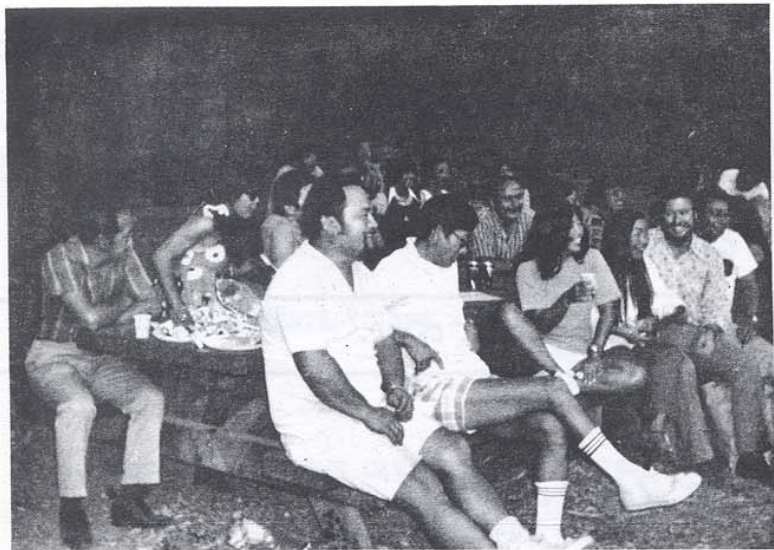

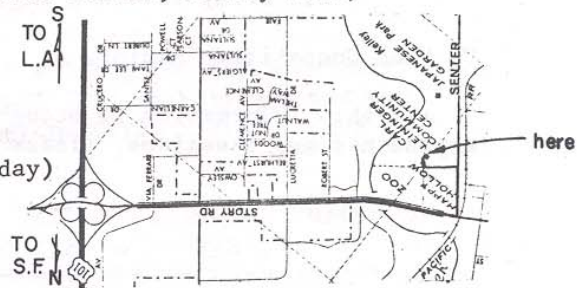
